Good morning,

I have not been ignoring you. I was off. I requested the file, at your request, to obtain a copy of the snapchat records and will send them to you if you still desire.

Let me be clear: the law was followed in this case. There is **no admissible evidence to proceed with prosecution of the Defendant**. As I have told you, Judge Valentine ruled that the snapchat records are unreliable. As I have also told you, I agree with that assessment, albeit for a completely different reason.
